I'm sure we all wish Gordon Stables well after his operation & all the best moving to the Isle of Wight to be with his son Ian. I know some of you have visited Gordon during his rehabilitation, and report his positive, can-do attitude. I will continue to send Parish Notices to Gordon so he can keep in contact with the centre's activities.

The big event you should attend in Sept is of course our annual track day, either as a participant or an onlooker. Details are shown later in this note.

We still have space on the Devon holiday if you wish to join do let me know.

Committee Update and request for volunteers.

We have several committee members who are stepping down at the November AGM for various reasons, so I am asking for volunteers to help us keep the club activities going.

If no one volunteers, it will inevitably mean reducing what we do to the time the committee can manage to invest in the centre.

1. Treasurer

After organising our special FolkMog Christmas Party over the last 4 years, John Riley will step aside following this year's event on 3rd December 2026. Steve Hodds has stepped forward to take the role from 2027 going forward.

Also after 10years of organising and leading the development of the highly successful Track-day John will be stepping aside.

FolkMog is the only MSCC Centre to have developed it's own track-day event, and over the years it has generated useful surplus income which has been used to fund and support many other club events, e.g. subsidising the 75th Anniversary, providing name badges, and placing wine on the tables at our Christmas events.

This event has established itself to be an important Centre and indeed National event, attracting MSCC members from all over the Country.

I am delighted to say that a successful handover period of 12 months has been completed and Chris Bennion is happy to take over the Lead Organiser role, and given the important funding status of this event, we know the event will be safe hands going forward. Given that it takes an enormous amount of time and effort to organise, Chris has requested that we appoint a new Treasurer to take over from him at the AGM.

I am therefore asking for a volunteer to take over the Treasurer's position from this years AGM in November. Chris has done some excellent work in streamlining the accounting process, so if you are interested please contact Chris or myself and we will talk you through the role.

Finally my thanks to John for his exemplary service to the centre & the committee.

2. Membership

Nigel is stepping down but is happy to run the South Noggin so we now need someone to maintain the database & welcome new joiners.

3. Webmaster & Regalia

Colin is stepping down from these roles after many years but will stay on the committee. He has worked hard to develop the website to it's current state from a concept.

The webmaster is again a key role as the website is the go-to point for the latest news, events etc. You will need to ensure event organisers keep you posted of any changes in this pivotal role. Plus you need to post club documents and in the gallery pictures of key events.

You don't need to be an IT genius as the website providers do all the coding you just need to cut & paste using an editing tool.

Regalia is a simpler role as the majority of items can be bought direct from logo that polo by members but it does involve managing our stock of car badges, windscreen stickers etc.

4. Safeguarding & Ladies events

Bev is stepping down. Whilst we can easily split the roles, I would hope one or more ladies would like to join the committee to at least lead the Ladies events. I know the Ladies events held so far have been well received. The recent visit to the Yum Yum Tree fudge factory, then lunch at the Norton Dog was, I hear, a great day for the ladies.

AGM November 2026

I will circulate in Oct a draft agenda for the AGM but feel free to let me have comments or agenda items before then.

Summer Break 2027

We are exploring a break in June to Jersey to a hotel I stayed at before with SwanMog & can recommend. This will replace the German Tour which is now running as a CX owners' event on the MSCC forum. The feedback from members on the German tour was that there was too much high speed driving leading to a very low take up, so we opted for Jersey.

We are asking now for expressions of interest. The details are:-

The summer break for FolkMog will be to Jersey on 11th–16th June 2027 – 5 nights.

Staying at the 4-star Hotel De France including complimentary Spa.

This hotel has been highly recommended by several members and is widely regarded as one of the best on Jersey.

We are still awaiting final pricing from the hotel (and we won't know the 2027 Ferry price until later this year- hotel will hopefully be slightly cheaper) but to give you an indication of price £1124 for a double room B&B plus £578 for fast ferry = £1702 per couple (£124 less for a car

and one person).

Once we have an idea of numbers for rooms, we can then do a further email confirming price and details of how to book your room direct with the hotel etc.

We suggest that FolkMoggers pay extra for a welcome dinner on the first night and a farewell dinner on the 15th of June. Other nights would be at members discretion.
