There will therefore be an event in Swannington on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> June and we are calling this event "Gardens @ Swannington":

- At least 3 gardens will open: Ugate Swannington (Bev and Mike's), Ugate Cottage and Swannington Manor. There could also be others
- Folkmog members are asked to arrive at Bev and Mikes for 10.30am, full address: Winsfield House, Ugate Swannington, Norwich NR9 5AH, we can then have a coffee before those that want to, leave for the guided walk

- For those that want to incorporate visiting the gardens with a walk, Bev will lead a guided walk, (bring appropriate walking shoes as we go through the woods), leaving Upgate Swannington at 11.00am. It's about an hours' walk
- Selected people are being invited to this event, including Folkmog and other social groups, plus local residents
- One garden will open up (between 11-4) and will provide savoury food
- One garden will open up (between 11-4) and will provide tea and cakes
- One of these gardens will also be selling plants
- Hosts very much want visitors to sit and chat in their gardens – there will be plenty of seating available
- Non-walkers can either walk the short distance from Bev and Mike's to the gardens that are opening or take their car and park on one of the commons
- Alternatively, Folkmog members can simply sit and socialise in Bev and Mike's garden, with their own picnic if they prefer
- Any profits from the food/drinks/plant sales will go to the Parkinsons charity
- People will be asked to bring CASH to pay for the food/drinks/plants
