There will be a choice of two routes for you to follow, going through the North Norfolk countryside, which will finish at the Holkham Hall Estate courtesy of the Earl and Countess of Leicester.

If you did the Blue Route last Year, do the Orange Route this year or vice versa.

**IMPORTANT**

The runs will start from Sheringham Station Road Car park NR26 8RE with registration commencing at 9.00am and closing at 10.15am sharp, after which time no Route Books will be issued. All participants must only enter the Holkham Estate through the South Gate NR23 1RX, which will be open from 1.00am. To gain entry on arrival, you must show your official Route Book to the marshals. There will be no access to the event parking area permitted via the main North Gate entrance to the Holkham Estate. Participants must also leave via the South Gate with **no exceptions**.

The Courtyard Café will be open with a large selection of food and beverages. There are also ample toilet facilities. Dogs are welcome in the Park but they must be kept on a lead and under control at all times, with any waste being picked up.
